Engagement of Short Term Consultants

Applications are invited from the experienced and retired officers in Line Departments of Government of Karnataka for engagement as Short Term Consultants in the above UNICEF-Project. The job description of the consultants are as follows.

- 1) Identification and classification of child-centric or child focused programmes and schemes by Departments by Head of Account on children (0-18 years) in GoK budget in 2019-20 and 2020-21 and to be budgeted in 2021-22 as per the format in Child Budget 2020-21.
- 2) Write up on description in English and Kannada language of 100% child-centric programmes and schemes in Central, State and District sectors by Departments (based on inputs received from the respective Departments).
- 3) Verification and validation of (1) with GoK departments.
- 4) Coordination and assistance for conduct of validation workshops with department at FPI.

Duration of engagement is 4 months on a consolidated consultation fee of Rs.2,00,000 (Rupees two lakh only).

Other things being equal, preference will be given to applicants who have worked in programmes and budget sections of Department Primary and Secondary Education, Department of Women and Child Development, Social Welfare Department, and Department of Health and Family Welfare.
